- Currently employed in a customer facing role (retail outlets; food handling outlets; pubs, clubs and hotels)
- Have not previously completed the individual Skill Set they are enrolling in.

COURSE OVERVIEW

- Follow standard and additional precautions for infection prevention and control
- Identify infection hazards and assess risks
- Follow procedures for managing risks associated with specific hazards.

ONLINE LEARNING & ASSESSMENTS

Students are enrolled in the training via our online learning management system. There, they have access to the learning material and assessments - students will need to complete knowledge questions, a detailed project and oral presentations conducted via Zoom.

Students have access to the online system 24/7 and also have a dedicated trainer and assessor who they can contact during business hours.

ON COMPLETION

On completing the Skill Set, the student will receive a Statement of Attainment for HLTINFCOV001 – Comply with infection prevention and control policies and procedures.
